ELIGIBILITY

Entries are open to any male or female amateur golfer who is a legal resident of Alabama or the Florida Panhandle (west of Apalachicola) and is at least six (6) years old by Monday, August 25, 2025. Entries are limited to the first fourteen (14) registrants per site.

Entries are subject to rejection or withdrawal at any time, including during the event, by Junior Golf Alabama (JGA), the Alabama-NW Florida PGA Section, and/or the host club/site. The reason for rejection may include unbecoming conduct during a lesson. All players must conform to the "USGA Rules of Amateur Status" as specified in "The Rules of Golf."

ENTRIES AND ONLINE REGISTRATION

All players must register online at https://www.juniorgolfalabama.org/programs. Fax, mail-in, or telephone applications are not accepted.

- All entries must be RECEIVED in the JGA office no later than 11:59pm, Tuesday, September 30, 2025. No entries will
 be accepted after that time.
- An entry fee of \$50.00, payable by credit card, must accompany the on-line entry application. Payment of the entry fee includes free Youth on Course membership and a Golf Handicap Information Network (GHIN) number.

Upon successfully completing the entry procedure, an email confirmation will be automatically generated and sent to you at the email address you designated.

The JGA is not responsible for errors or delays by any internet service provider. Entries are only accepted between the open and close dates as stated above. Confirmation of acceptance is sent to players when their status is determined. Status may be checked at: https://www.golfgenius.com/pages/5359835. The appropriate entry fee must be paid by each player at time of registration.

Please be advised that all online entry applications for players who are minors, upon date of submission, in the state in which they reside (e.g. Alabama/Florida, under the age of 18) must be submitted by a parent/guardian, must list the parent/guardian's name, phone number, and e-mail address. The parent/guardian agrees to be bound by all the terms and conditions on their own behalf and on behalf of the minor player. The JGA reserves the right to require submission of an original signature of the parent/guardian in a confirmation copy of the application upon notification by the AGA to the parent/guardian.

REFUND POLICY

Withdrawal: If a registered participant withdraws for any reason before the close of registration at 11:59pm on Tuesday, September 30, 2025, the entry fee will be refunded, subject to a \$5.00 service fee. If a registered participant withdraws for any reason after the close of registration and before the start of the second scheduled session, 75% of the entry fee will be refunded. No refunds will be made after the site's second scheduled session. No Shows: Registrants who fail to notify the JGA of their withdrawal and "No Show" the first scheduled session will not receive a refund for any reason.
